

# 2023 Neuroscience Art Competition Entry Form

The BYU Neuroscience Center invites neuroscience majors to submit creative works expressing the beauty of neuroscience on the theme of “Neurogenesis”. Neuroscience is not just a conceptually beautiful field—it’s full of gorgeous images (and talented students) as well.

Entries will be judged on aesthetic merit and how they reflect the theme “Neurogenesis”. Each student can only submit one entry. Five winners will be chosen by neuroscience faculty and staff representatives, and prizes will be awarded as follows:

**1st Prize: \$300**

**2nd Prize: \$200**

**3rd Prize: \$100**

**2 awards for Honorable Mention: \$50 each**
